Blanche Hoschedé-Monet was a French Impressionist painter, born in (1) Paris in 1865. Her mother, Alice, later married Claude Monet, making Blanche his (2) stepdaughter.

Blanche began painting at a young age and became (3) Monet's only student. They often painted together (4) outdoors, capturing the same scenes. Her style closely resembled Monet's, and she created many (5) landscapes and garden scenes.



In 1897, <u>(6) Blanche</u> married Jean Monet, Claude's son. They lived in Rouen and Beaumont-le-Roger. After <u>(7) Jean's death</u> in 1914, Blanche returned to <u>(8) Giverny</u> to care for Claude Monet, who was struggling with his health. She <u>(9) managed his household</u> and supported him during his later years.

After Monet's death in (10) 1926, (11) Blanche continued to paint and took care of his house and famous gardens in Giverny. She exhibited her work and maintained the property until (12) her death in 1947. Today, her contributions to Impressionism are gaining recognition.
