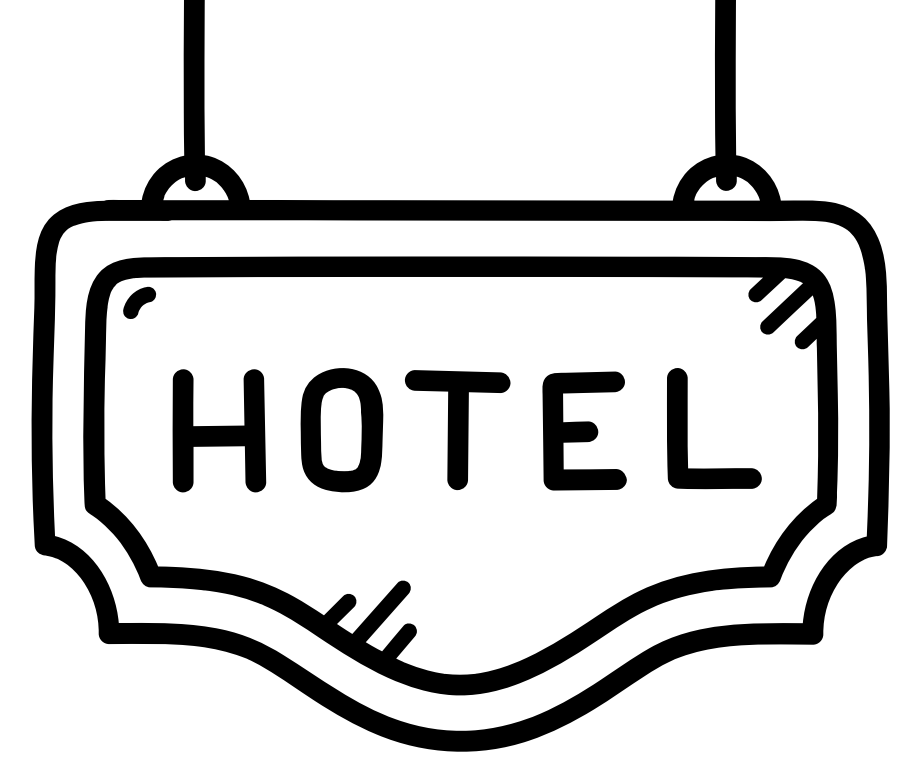


# Travel Talk

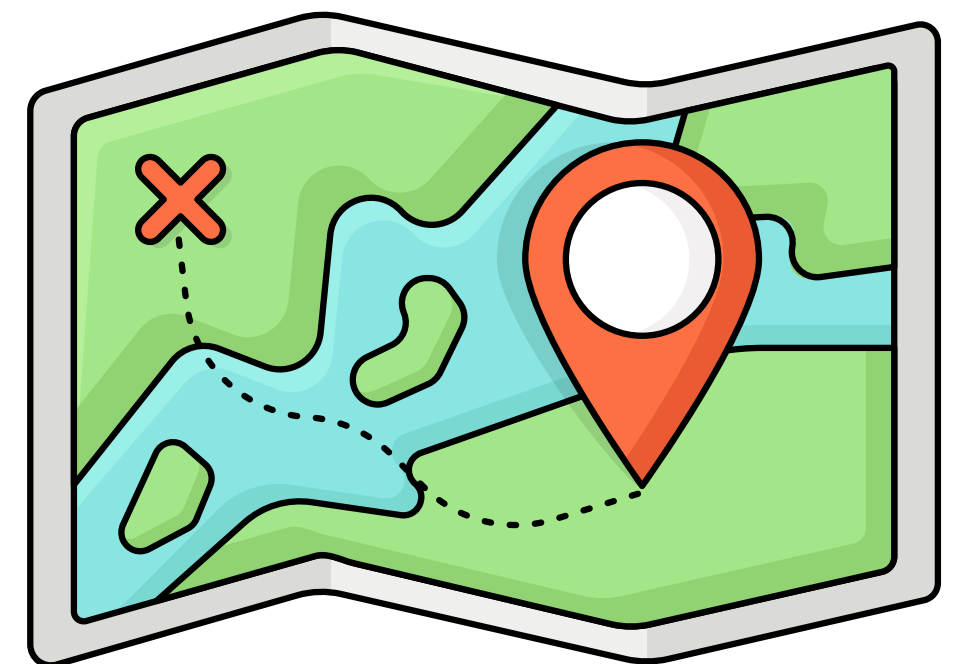
## Tip #4

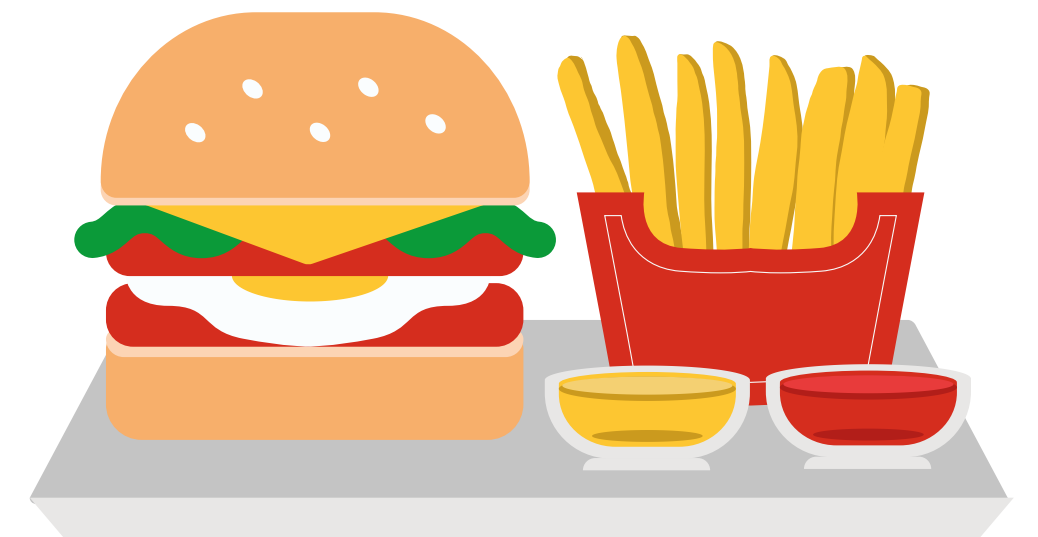
## Tip #7
