When do we use the Present Simple?

We use the Present Simple to talk about:

- Routines and habits
 - I get up at 7. I drink coffee every morning.
- Facts and things that are always true
 - Water boils at 100°C.
- Things that happen regularly
 - She plays tennis on weekends.



Key words: always, usually, often, sometimes, never, every day, on Mondays...

When do we use the Present Continuous?

We use the Present Continuous to talk about:

- Actions happening right now
 - I'm reading a book right now.
- Temporary actions
 - She's staying with her sister this week.
- Things happening around the current time
 - They're studying a lot these days.
- Things we see or hear at the moment
 - Look! The cat is running.



Key words: now, right now, at the moment, today, this week, these days, Look!, Listen!
